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Dear Student Athlete and Parents:

We are concerned about the health and well being of our student athletes. It is important that you review your child's intercollegiate sports participation with your medical insurance agent so you can be advised as to the amount and type of coverage that is appropriate.

Prior to practice or play as a member of any intercollegiate team, every student athlete at Coe College must meet the following guidelines:

- 1) Have a record of physical examination on file with Coe College. First year and transfer students must have a physical examination completed **six months** prior to enrolling at Coe. A copy of Coe College's physical form is located on this site. Please have this form completed and returned to Melinda Brokaw, Director of Health Services, prior to August 1st, 2011.
- 2) Enclosed on this site you will find a section of information that needs to be completed and returned to Leah Fuhrman by August 1st, 2011. These 2 pages include Mandatory **Health Insurance Certification and Demographic information**. Coe College does not provide supplemental insurance nor will it pay for any medical bills resulting from athletic participation. Every student athlete at Coe is required to have their medical insurance meet the listed requirements on this form. One of these requirements is to ensure that student athletes have enough insurance to meet the NCAA provided catastrophic insurance policy. The NCAA provides catastrophic insurance coverage to all NCAA students athletes in the event that an injury or illness exceeds \$90,000. In addition to completing this information, each student athlete will be required to submit a **copy of both sides of his or her insurance card**. This will be placed on file in the event that medical assistance is needed.

If a student athlete requires health care while participating in intercollegiate athletics at Coe, he or she will have access to our certified athletic training staff. If deemed necessary, the student athlete may be referred to a Coe team physician by our staff. The Coe College athletic training staff has gained a reputation of excellence in our conference and in Cedar Rapids.
